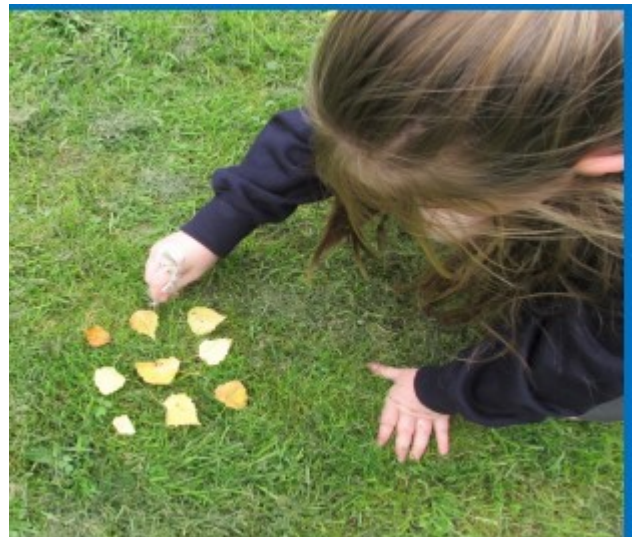
Yesterday we had our joint safer schools meeting where we looked at
