
The council are carrying out traffic surveys to find out about the extent of speeding in the area and what further measures would be necessary. We now have members of staff out at the start and end of the school day and we are increasing the number of special assemblies and education programmes on road safety within the schools. The police have also listened to our concerns and will increase police presence where necessary and see what further measures can be implemented.


