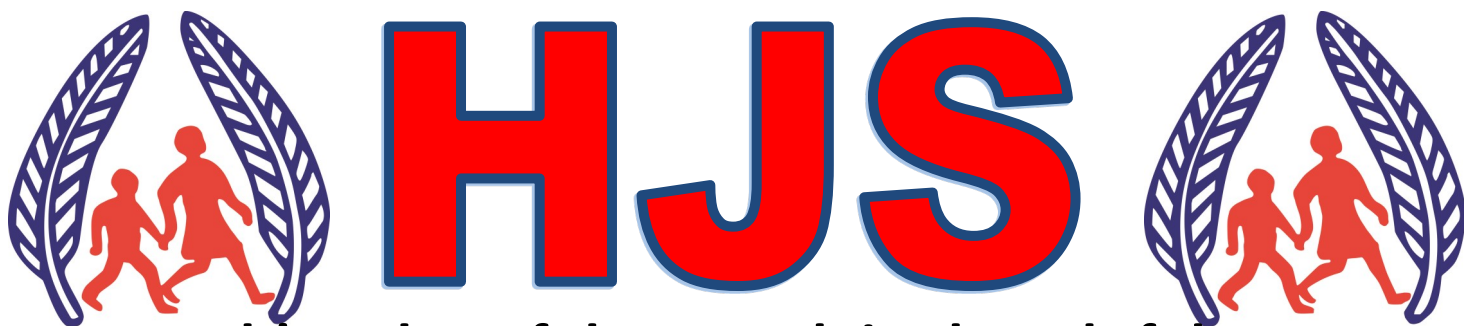
Road Safety Meeting
