



#### **Road Safety Reminder**

At The PELICAN CROSSING outside school, DO NOT START TO CROSS once the green man starts to flash.

When the green man starts to flash, the traffic is shown a flashing amber signal at the same time. The flashing amber signal means that traffic must give way to pedestrians as they complete their crossing but may pull away once the crossing is clear.

Keep looking and listening for traffic whilst crossing rather than looking at the green man on the far side of the road.

Please park WELL CLEAR of the crossing to give everyone the best chance of seeing each other – both drivers and cyclists approaching the crossing and families and children using the crossing. Thank you.
